[About the proposed site]

Q: Is it necessary to consider a specific site for the proposal? Or should I start with a general idea and consider the specific location only after selection?

A: It is not necessary to decide on a specific site when you propose your project(s). Even if you find a specific site, that location may be changed depending on various circumstances (such as problems receiving permission of use). If you do not list any specific site, the site will be decided after selection.

[About the budget]

Q: Is it necessary to include the transportation, accommodations, and shipping fees in the proposed budget? If not, how are they handled?

A: The budget should include everything, such as transportation onto site, accommodations, and shipping expenses. Regarding the accommodations, we plan to prepare a dormitory (shared room).

Q: Does the maximum budget of 2.5 million yen include everything when producing works? For example, translation costs and removal costs as well?

A: They must be included.

[About the selection process]

Q: If I live abroad, do I have to meet in person for the interview? Is it possible to have an online interview?

A: It is possible to have an interview online.

[About the documents to submit]

Q: Do I have to write my resume in Japanese?

A: Please write in Japanese or English.
